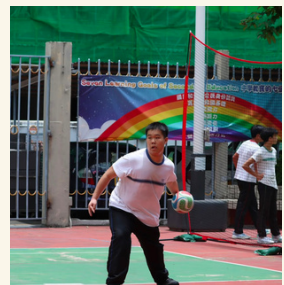
Teacher-Student Football & Basketball Match

An Interview with the Principal

Q: What study methods did you use when you were a student? How do you share these valuable experiences to encourage students today?

A: Due to the intense university admission competition in my era—with only 2,000 places available for approximately 120,000 candidates—I adopted an examination-oriented approach. Beyond mastering the fundamentals, I focused on rigorous question drilling and analyzed paper-setting patterns from the examiner's perspective. This method proved highly effective, earning me A grades in Economics, History, and Chinese History. Later, as an educator at our school, I implemented the same pedagogy. Consequently, during the A-Level era, 50% of my students achieved grades C or above, and I maintained a 100% pass rate for over 10 years.

Q: How do you relax after work? Are there any methods you can recommend to students?

A: In my free time, I enjoy watching comedies and listening to music as a way to relax. I also practice meditation and quiet sitting.

Q: What was the biggest challenge you faced during your school years, and how did you overcome it?

A: The toughest part of being a student for me was the studying and the exams. I always felt I had to clear my mind, because too many thoughts would interfere with my performance.

Q: Do you have any memorable school experiences from your student days that you would like to share with us?

A: One memory that really stands out is that most of my secondary school teachers were incredibly kind . I think it was because I was proactive about learning and always showed gratitude. In return, they were happy to spend their personal time giving me one-on-one guidance after school. That's how I picked up the key techniques so quickly—and saw great results. Those teachers gave me unforgettable experiences.

Q: What are your expectations and encouragements for our students' growth and development?

A: My greatest expectation is that every student grows not only in knowledge , but also in character, curiosity, and resilience. I want our students to be lifelong learners who are not afraid to make mistakes, because mistakes are where real growth begins.

As a principal, I always remind our students that ‘To trust in the Lord is the beginning of wisdom.’ Whether in academics or in life, we build everything on this foundation.

Q: Do you have any encouragement or blessings for students taking the DSE and for all students in the school?

A: Let's work hard on our English and Chinese, aim for university, and never give up no matter how tough it gets. Remember, God is on our side.
