Although the majority of people find it difficult to learn English, I believe it is actually quite simple. Obviously, studying relentlessly is one way to go about it, but personally, I believe that being alone will never result in possessing a high level of knowledge regarding the English language. It is not yet sufficient enough. However, not much more effort is actually required for it to be enough. In my case, I have only needed to implement two habits into my daily life to garner a greater level of knowledge, which I will be discussing next.

First of all, I regularly expose myself to English-related content. I consider this to be the most essential and indispensable habit that you must develop, as it will tremendously improve your comprehension if you consistently carry it out on a daily basis. I have been doing this for quite some time now and have developed some habits over the years, for example, reading English novels, watching English videos for entertainment, and turning on English subtitles when watching a TV show. All of these have helped me get used to the speech patterns of native English speakers, including commonly used phrases or words, resulting in a deeper understanding of the natural flow of English. This has greatly assisted me in swiftly comprehending passages during tests or exams, significantly increasing my chances of answering questions correctly.

Secondly, I communicate with English speakers from time to time. The reason for this is simple. Not only can they correct your mistakes, but it also helps familiarize yourself with forming correct and natural sentences. Although it is less important than exposure to English-related content, these two habits go hand in hand, as the former provides you with insight into the natural flow of English, and the latter allows you to actually utilize the newly found knowledge. I have made a few online friends who speak English, and we regularly text through social media platforms. When I first met them, my English was average, but they helped me immensely with my uncertainties, so I never feel afraid to ask people for help. It will benefit you greatly in the long term. Besides, I could also learn from how they text, or in other words, how they piece different words together, which has helped me with my writing.

And that is all I have done to transform myself into the person I am today. Thank you for taking the time to read this.

## 行業介紹展 --醫療行業






